



## Procedures and Protocols

**All individuals planning to attend the event must self-monitor for any COVID-19 symptoms** (fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat or loss of taste/smell). Any individual expecting to attend the event who begins to display any symptoms prior to or enroute to the event **MUST NOT** attend the event. Any participants with anyone in their household who is immune compromised is encouraged to **STAY HOME**.

All trucks, trailers, motorhomes, and personal vehicles should be actively disinfected by individual attendees prior to arrival at the event.

Cloth face coverings are recommended but not required, at the event. However, those unable to maintain 6 ft. distance from others not in their racing cohort must wear a face covering. Hand washing stations and hand sanitizer will be available at the facility and attendees are encouraged to wash hands frequently for 20 seconds – we ask that participants bring their own sanitizing supplies, as well. Everyone on the property must have a pit pass. Gates will be closed and locked once racing begins. **NO LATE ENTRY IS ALLOWED. Racing cohorts can be no larger than 10 people per race car including the driver. Attendees must remain in those cohorts throughout the duration of the event, while maintaining social distancing, and must not comingle with other participant cohorts.** ALL SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES MUST BE OBSERVED AT ALL TIMES. Anyone in the facility who refuses to follow any guidelines will be withdrawn from the event and removed from the facility.

**Delta Speedway will only use electronic forms of communication for posting lineups.** Lineups will not be posted on the pit board near the pit shack. Participants should download the FREE MyRacePass app to stay informed regarding race schedules and lineups. Live timing can be found for a fee on the MyRacePass app or on Race Monitor.

**There will be no in-person drivers' meeting.** Participants will be given a drivers' meeting handout when they check-in. Drivers are expected to follow the meeting guidelines. Check-in will be staggered by class. Each class will be called to the pit shack separately, to avoid the gathering of crowds. When called to the pit shack for check-in, the entire driver cohort must arrive at the pits shack together. **Drivers MUST download and complete all required forms from the website prior to the event. ALL ATTENDEES MUST ALSO DOWNLOAD, SIGN AND BRING THE COVID WAIVER.** These are non-spectator events and all attendees must purchase a pit pass.

**Attendees are always to maintain 6 feet social distance from others.** Do not congregate at the track entrance near Delta officials. You may observe your car from the conex box or the various grandstand areas throughout the facility, always maintaining 6 feet distance from others.
